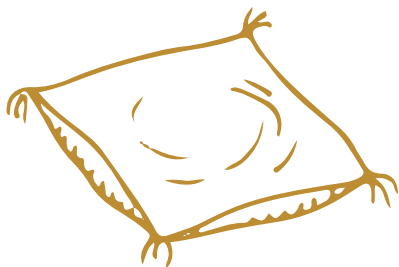
Amenities

- *“Dog” door sign*

Rules of Conduct

1. Since families with small children and other dog owners also stay with us, we ask that you please stay on a leash at all times throughout the entire hotel grounds for safety reasons. A leash requirement also applies throughout the whole municipality of Going.
2. Please never sit on chairs, benches, or sofas, as other guests will want to sit there after you.
3. For hygiene reasons, please do not use our Kaiserwiese meadow, or the terrace, lawn, or balcony in front of your room, for toileting. You're very welcome to use the walking routes described on the following pages, as well as the many footpaths and hiking trails. For more information, our concierge is happy to help in person or by phone at extension 902.
4. Out of respect for our two-legged guests – and especially for our farmers – please ALWAYS pick up after your dog and dispose of it in the nearest bin. Extra poop bags are available at reception or at the many bins along the paths.
5. Please always keep a sufficient safety distance from cows and other animals, and keep your dog on a leash whenever you're near them.
6. So that we can continue to enjoy the many footpaths, hiking trails, and alpine pastures that our farmers kindly make available to us, please be sure to follow the rules for using them!
7. If you've had a great time in the mud on your way back, please wash your paws at the dedicated dog-washing stations by the entrances. Additional towels and blankets are also available in your room on request — just contact reception, in person or by phone at extension 999

Areas You Can Enjoy

At Stanglwirt and in the surrounding area, there's plenty of room for you and your family.

*In our **traditional „Gasthof Stangl“**, you're **always welcome** at mealtimes too. If your family would like to bring you along to breakfast or dinner in the Dreiklang or Leni's restaurant, a reservation in our Zirbenstube parlour is possible on request and subject to availability. Please book in advance at reception or directly via table reservations at **extension 7983**.*

*Until **8:00 p.m.**, you're also welcome to join us at the **hotel bar**.*

*You're **welcome** at the **indoor and outdoor tennis courts** too, where you can watch your mum & dad rally back and forth. You can also visit your family at the **riding stable** to see the horses.*

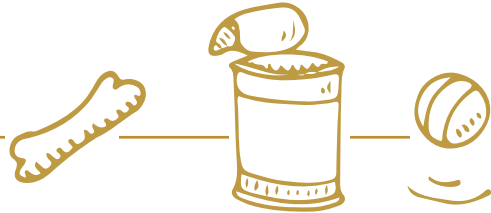

Dog Sitter

Don't be sad if your parents want to spend a day among two-legged company only, head to the hotel bar in the evening, or their spa appointment runs a little longer. Our concierge is happy to arrange a dog sitter for you during that time, so you don't have to stay alone in the room.

Please understand that short-notice requests may not always be possible.

Dog Walks

In the area around Stanglwirt there are numerous scenic walking routes for an unforgettable outing together. Please observe the leash requirement, especially when grazing livestock is nearby, keep a safe distance from other animals or people, and use poop bags to help keep our landscape clean.

Prama loop (Koasastadl-See (lake)), duration: 50 min.

Kaiserweg uphill – 3rd junction right towards the lake – keep right on Reischweg towards “Koasastadl” – follow Aschauerweg uphill – left back via Kaiserweg to Stanglwirt

Schwendter loop, duration: 1h.

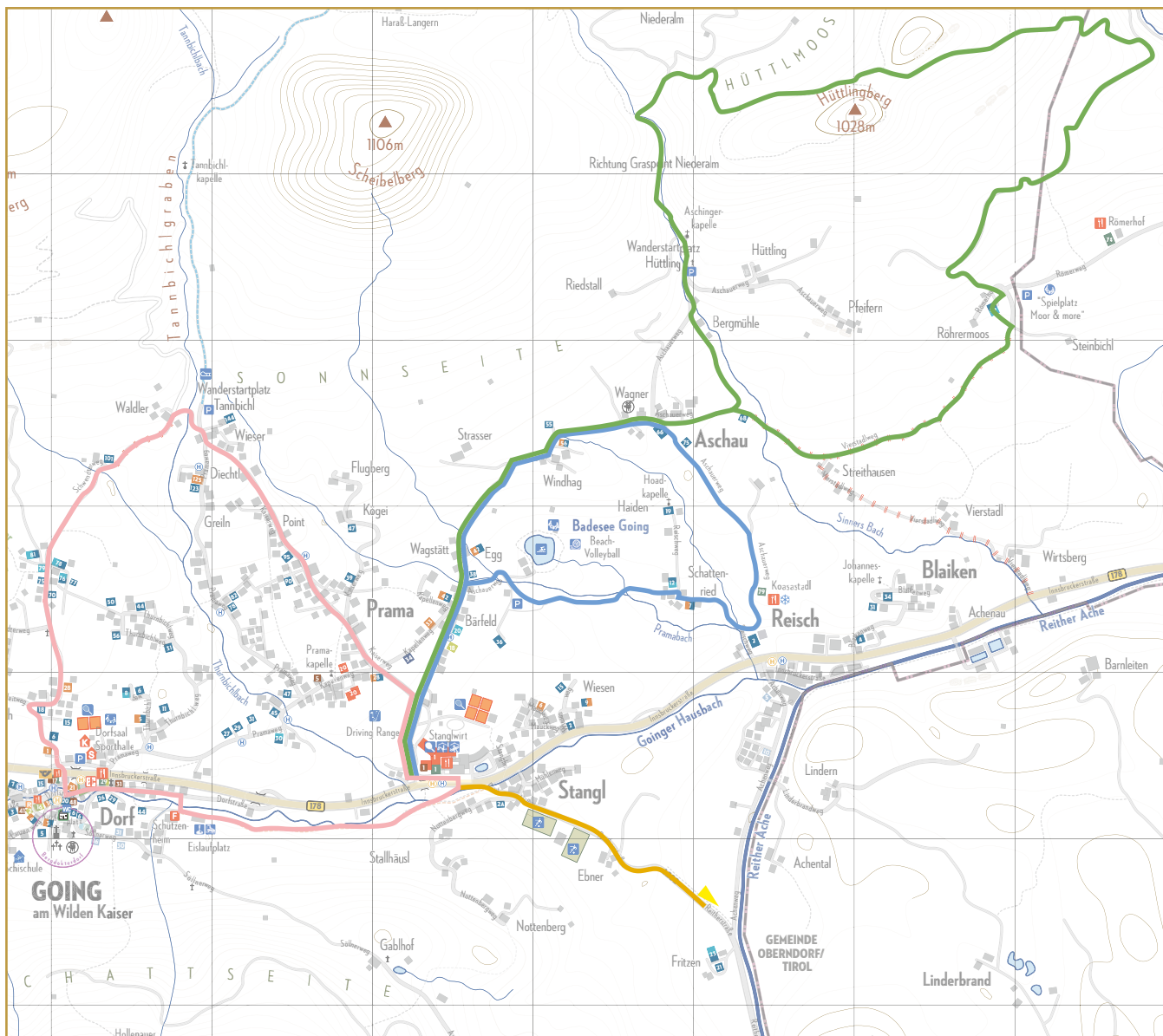
Kaiserweg uphill – 1st junction left towards Prama – continue straight on Kaiserweg – follow Pramaweg / Schwendterweg through the woods and keep left – take the underpass into the village – follow the village street left to the fire station car park – follow the path back through the woods towards Stanglwirt (underpass by the small bridge)

Schwarzsee loop, duration: 1h.

By car via Reith to Kitzbühel – turn left opposite the golf course towards Schwarzsee

Moor & More, duration: 3h.

Follow Kaiserweg / Aschauerweg uphill – at the “Hausberger” guesthouse, follow the “Rocky Runde” signage left / right

*If something gets **broken** or **heavily soiled** while playing, please understand that we may need to invoice the damages, depending on their extent.*

*Likewise, we reserve the right to charge a **cleaning fee of € 280,-** if the rules of conduct are not observed in the room or on the balconies.*

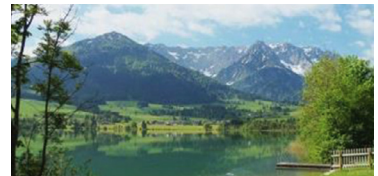

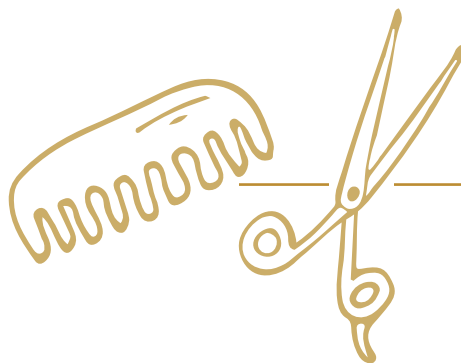
